- To have personal information kept confidential
- To seek clarification and grievance redressal in a timely manner

Responsibilities of Investors

- To provide accurate and complete information while availing services
- To understand that research is not a guarantee of returns
- To make independent investment decisions based on risk appetite
- To read all disclosures and terms carefully before acting on research

Do's and Don'ts for Investors

- Do evaluate your risk profile before investing
- Do seek clarification if any research aspect is unclear
- Don't assume assured or guaranteed returns
- Don't act solely on past performance or market rumors

Grievance Redressal Mechanism

In case of any grievance related to research services, investors may first contact the Research Analyst directly. If the grievance is not resolved satisfactorily, investors may escalate the matter to SEBI through SCORES (<https://scores.sebi.gov.in>).
